****DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE CLEARANCE LETTER IS REQUIRED****

This 24-hour course will provide the student with a basic knowledge of firearms, as well as related safety and liability issues. **Each student must provide the following equipment on the first day of class:**

- Semi-automatic pistols with at least 3 magazines or a revolvers with at least 2 speedy loaders (revolvers will be at a disadvantage during the firearms testing. The test is timed and reloads will need to be performed in the allotted time). No barrel lengths shorter than 3 inches
- Holster- The holster must be of a design which provides some retention. A level 2 or 3 is preferred. No Nylon holsters. The holster must remain open, after drawing the weapon. It must fasten to a belt or Sam Browne. The student must demonstrate that the holster remains in place, while drawing the firearm
- Ammunition- 600 rounds minimum are required to complete the training and testing process. The rounds must be factory and can be full metal jacket, hollow point or frangible. No reloads or lead rounds
- Firearms- semi-autos shall be in calibers 9MM, .40 S&W, .45ACP, revolvers shall be double action, at least 6 shots, and in calibers .38 SPL, .357, .44, .45 Long Colt. No magnum rounds

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING DOJ CLEARANCE LETTER

- Visit the California Attorney General's website, <u>www.ag.ca.gov/firearms</u>
- Under General Information, go to Forms and Publications, look for Request for Live-scan Service for POST certification, download live-scan form
- Take the form to a Police Department or other agency that provides live-scan services
- Keep receipt with ATI number for tracking
