This course consists of 30 hours of classroom instruction, covering topics such as Professionalism and Ethics, Criminal Justice System, Search and Seizure, Report Writing, Use of Force and Laws of Arrest and several others. An additional 10

hours is spent teaching the students current defensive tactics and arrest control techniques. Students should be in good physical condition, and be able to perform arrest control techniques and searches. There is a practical application test for the defensive tactics segment and a written test for the classroom instruction. The student must pass both tests in order to
