## Deputy Sheriff Trainee Position

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- AGE: Must be at least 21 years of age on date of appointment.
- CITIZENSHIP: Must be a U.S. citizen, or qualification under California Government Code Section 1031.5. or permanent resident alien who has filed for citizenship prior to the date of application.
- EDUCATION: U.S. High School Diploma OR-U.S. General Education Development Credential (GED) OR- A California High School Proficiency Certificate OR- Have attained a two-year or four-year degree from a U.S. accredited college or university.
- BACKGROUND: Must have no domestic violence convictions and cannot currently be the subject of a domestic violence restraining order.
  Must have no felony convictions as a juvenile or adult and cannot currently be on any form of probation AND must pass an extensive background investigation to the satisfaction of the Sheriff-Coroner.
- DRIVER'S LICENSE: Must possess a valid California Driver's License, Class C or higher by date of appointment.



# **Correctional Services Assistant Position**

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- AGE: Must be at least 18 years of age on date of appointment.
- EDUCATION: U.S. High school diploma OR-General Education Development Credential (GED) OR-Passage of the California High School Proficiency Test OR-Attainment of a two-year or four-year degree from an accredited college or university, by date of appointment.
- BACKGROUND: Must have no prior felony convictions. Passage of comprehensive background investigation, physical agility test, and medical examination to the satisfaction of the Sheriff-Coroner Department.
- LICENSE/CERTIFICATION: A valid California Class C Driver's License, or the ability to utilize an alternative method of transportation when needed to carry out job-related essential functions. May require a valid California Class B Driver's License.
