TRAINING COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

Homeless Death Investigation

This eight-hour course will provide training on essential aspects of homelessness and death investigation related to homelessness. It offers introductory knowledge and investigative tools associated with a homeless death investigation. It will address laws, tools to help identify homeless decedents, tactics, identification and notifications of next of kin's, and challenges in death investigation as a whole when it comes to the homeless community. It will cover programs dealing with the homeless community, the need for a specialized death investigation and familiarizes students system of care.

Topics include History of homelessness, trends, statistics and best practices, review of laws as it relates to homelessness. Medical and psychological issues as it relates to homelessness. Familiarization with Homeless Outreach Team and Homeless Liaison Officer. Community awareness and resources, political influences, including positive and challenging impacts on response to homelessness. Training on Death Investigation, review and discussion on cause of death and Mannering deaths for homeless cases.
